# Heard Myths About Tankless Water Heaters?

- ❑ The Ruinnai Endless Hot Water Heater is not a tankless water heater. This is an instant hot water heater. It is designed to give a constant flow of hot water where and when you need it without having to maintain that hot water in a storage tank.
- ❑ It's energy-efficient and long-lasting.
- ❑ Almost no maintenance is required.
- ❑ Gets up to 5.5 gallons/minute.
  - Your tank water heater produces about 0.6 GPM.



# Save up to 40% on Your Water Heating Costs

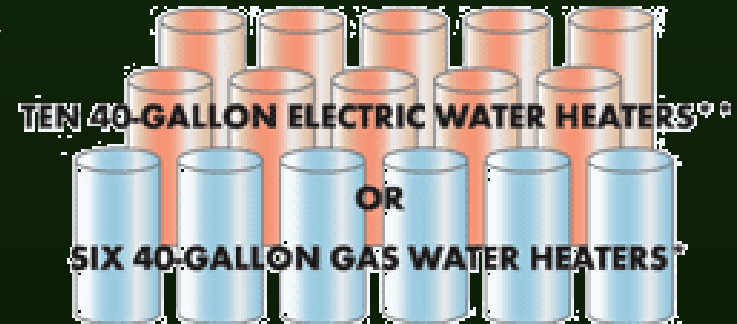
- The Rinnai unit only uses energy when you request hot water and remains off the remainder of the time since it doesn't have a full tank to heat.
- Rinnai offers a line of controllers that make it easy to set water temperatures precisely for multiple locations in your home to ensure comfort and prevent scalding accidents.

## Estimated Annual Energy Cost



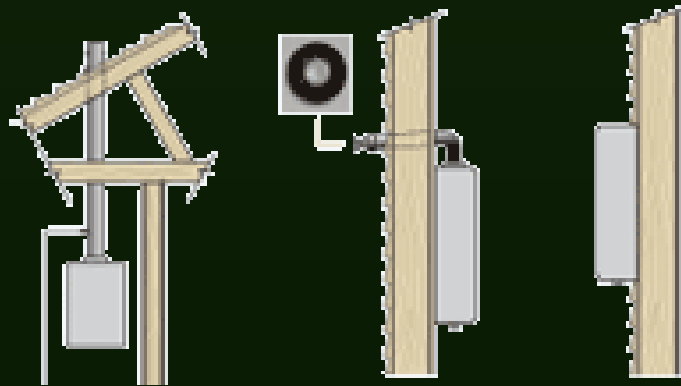
# Extra Capacity

- A Rinnai Endless Hot Water Heater can produce up to six times what your tank water heater can supply.
- Rinnais can be used singly, or with other units to meet any demands—residential, commercial, or multi-family.
- it can also perform wonders you've only dreamed of. It can:
  - Heat your towels
  - Melt the snow on your driveway
  - Run three showers at the same time
  - Run a load of laundry and a shower at the same time.



# Installation Perks

# Clean, Fresh Water Every Time

- Has your water ever tasted rusty?
- Are you uncomfortable with the idea of bacteria growing in the water supply you use for drinking and bathing?
- With regular tank water heaters, rust and scale build up in the bottom of the tank where the water is stored.
- Because there is no tank, Rinnais give you clean, fresh water every time.
- You also won't have to worry about cracks and flooding!



# Do the Math, Keep Your Savings

## □ Equipment Costs:

- Average Life of a Rinnai: 25 years
- Average Life of a Regular Water Heater: 10 years
- You will replace regular water heaters twice in the lifetime of a Rinnai:  $2 \times 2 \times 850/\text{ea} = \$3400$

## □ Operating Costs:

- Rinnai Operating Cost: \$223/yr
- Regular Water Heater: \$562/yr
- Difference per year Savings=  $\$339 \times 25 \text{ yrs} = \$8,475$  savings

## □ Total Savings:

- \$8,475 Operating Cost
- +\$3,400 Replacements Cost
- \$11,875 Total Savings in 25 years
- Average Savings per Year: \$475;  
Average Payback: 2.6 years

# And Don't Forget About Your Extra Savings Opportunities



- The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 signed on February 17, 2009 made significant changes to homeowner tax credits for specified energy-efficient home improvements including qualifying residential water heaters and boilers.
- Homeowners who purchase and install a qualifying Rinnai tankless water heater or boiler between Jan. 1, 2009 and Dec. 31, 2010 are eligible for a tax credit equal to 30% of the full purchase and installation price up to a maximum of \$1500.
- Also earn a \$300 Questar rebate.
